CALL FOR ABSTRACT

Participants are cordially invited to submit their **original unpublished research** contributions in any of the relevant sections of PSC-26 that address the theme of the National Conference. All submitted abstracts will undergo a review process to ensure their quality and relevance. Acceptance will be duly intimated through E-mail.

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT(S) SUBMISSION

- The abstract should not exceed 300 words.
- The abstract should cover the Title of paper; Full name of the author in Capital letters; Affiliation; E-mail of corresponding Author and Contact Number
- Font - Times New Roman, Font size-12, Single line spacing, Page layout-A4 in MS Word.
- The section in which the abstract is being submitted must be mentioned in the subject of E-mail.
- Selected papers will be consider for publication.

PRESENTATION (ORAL/POSTER)

There will be parallel technical sessions for oral /presentations for each section. Ten minutes shall be given for Oral presentation (seven minutes for presentation and three minutes for discussion). For Poster presentation, each participant will be provided with a space of 30" x 36" inch for displaying the written material, diagrams, photographs etc. **Best Poster** in each section will be awarded a medal, certificate and a prize of Rs. 2100/-by the Punjab Academy of Sciences.

YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD

A special offline session for the presentation of papers for the young scientist award will be held on February 8, 2026. Young scientists up to the age of 35 years on January 15, 2026 may send their abstracts and full length papers to the Secretary, Punjab Academy of Sciences, Union Building, Punjabi University, Patiala, separately on or before **January 15, 2026**. Name of the Section pertaining to the paper should be clearly mentioned on the envelope. **One additional Young Scientist award** will be given to the person who present his/her research in Punjabi Language. The abstract of this paper should be submitted online at pasciences@gmail.com. The Young scientists (proof of age to be furnished) selected for best presentation will be awarded a certificate of honor, medal and cash prize of Rs. 7500/-.
